

March 2025 Meeting Report

MTF Strategic Actions for 2025-26

Members are invited to nominate transport actions from their own Council Plans which can be used to inform the strategic actions for the MTF. These might be policy, advocacy, or research ideas. Please let the EO know.

<u>February Speaker – Dr Ben Rossiter – Chief</u> <u>Executive – Victoria Walks</u>

Dr Rossiter provided an overview of the place that walking has in our day to day lives. – it is the most popular recreation activity, and an integral part of any transport activity. It is the mode we most recall when we take trips, and that it is vital that walking is considered fundamental when planning activity centres – which must be interesting and attractive to encourage walking around and through neighbourhoods. He said "PT is simply an interruption to a good walk".

Ben encouraged members to advocate for a dedicated walking element with the budget, proposing that \$250million should be sought for accessible walks, and the creation of 1000 new crossings (not all of these need to be signalised) with a budget of \$100million.

2025 Ambassador Positions

The six Ambassador roles (Accessibility, Buses, Cycling, Trams, Trains and Walking) will be considered once we have our new strategic action plan.

Council Information Sharing

No reports were sought this month. Next month we look forward to hearing from Banyule, Bayside, Boroondarah and Brimbank.
